RULES FOR Paddock USERS

Please take note of the rules on using the paddock and stalls at the Circuit Paul Ricard to ensure the site is respected.

- The speed limit is **10 km/h** and the **French highway code** applies.
- **Animals are not allowed** in the paddock.
- Unauthorized persons are **not allowed** to enter the **pit lane** and all other **safety areas**.
- **Access** to waste collection points, striped areas and facilities in the paddock (stairs, toilets etc.) must be **kept clear**.
- **Smoking is not allowed** in the stalls and cigarette butts must be deposited in the ashtrays provided.
- **Food** may not be **cooked inside** the stalls. Only **electric barbecues** are allowed in the paddock; fires and other types of fuel are **prohibited**.


- The use of corrosive and/or environmentally harmful products is **strictly forbidden**. Only water and eco-responsible products are **allowed** for the cleaning of vehicles.
- Fuels, oils and other authorized **hazardous substances** must be handled with the utmost care. **Fuel drums may not be stored** in the stalls.
- When mechanical work is being carried out on vehicles, **floors must be protected** with environmentally friendly mats and **protective equipment must be worn**.
- **In the event of an incident** (oil stains, leaks etc.), **absorbent material** is available at reception or in the paddock. *(See the number at the bottom of the page.)*
- **It is strictly forbidden to dispose of** any type of waste and used liquids outside the dedicated collection systems. *(See the sorting instructions displayed.)*
- **It is strictly forbidden to attach tents to the boxes**, a white marking on the ground defines the area.
- Any kind of damage to the floors or walls (markings, fixings, graffiti, drilling etc.) is forbidden. Ballasts are available at welcome desk - pitbuilding *(subject to availability)*.
- **Any material damage or operating incidents** (leakages, power surges, fire etc.) must be reported **IMMEDIATELY** to the Paddock team. *(See the number at the bottom of the page.)*

- Cables may not be laid **outside** the designated **pathways**.
- The **connections** in the computer bays may not be **modified**.
- **No removable structures** (tents, awnings etc.) or **POS advertising** (flags, banners etc.) may be installed in the helicopter take-off area. *(See the brown area on the map below.)*
- All temporary displays must be collected at the **end of each event**.
- Any lost property must be returned to the **Pit Building reception**.
- Any items provided by the circuit in the garage (mats, fire blankets, fire extinguishers etc.) which are missing when the teams leave **will be subject to a charge**.
- **Charges apply to the removal of any abandoned items** (petrol drums, oil cans etc.).
- **Drifting within the circuit premises is prohibited**, subject to immediate billing (€300 per mark).
- **It is forbidden to mark the floor and walls** (with spray paint, paint, or other substances).

A sports penalty and/or a charge may be applied in case of non-compliance with this regulation.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

PREAMBLE

The Rules and Regulations are a document governing the relationship between any person entering the Circuit (as defined below) and the General Management of the Circuit Paul Ricard. It defines the general conditions of use of the Circuit. It is intended to clarify the obligations of all and to ensure safety and security on the site.

It is reminded the dangerous nature of the activities taking place on the Circuit. Anyone accessing the enclosure of the Circuit accepts and assumes full responsibility for the risks incurred as a result of his presence or participation in activities occurring within the Circuit without recourse against the General Management, unless it is proven inexcusable fault of the latter.

ARTICLE 1 - DEFINITIONS

Circuit: means all the enclosed spaces, located at 2760, Route des Hauts du Camp, 83330 Le Castellet, including the Circuit Paul Ricard and all the facilities necessary for its operation.

General Management: means the decision-making bodies of the Operator.

Event: means any public event of any nature whatsoever, including sporting, recreational or cultural, taking place at the Circuit with ticketing (race, concert, show, etc.).

Private Event: means any event of a private nature, without ticketing, taking place within the Circuit, including corporate events, seminars and team building, receptions of customers or suppliers, product presentations, track hire and driving sessions, event operations, filming, etc.

Operator: designates the EXCELIS Company, 2760 Route des Hauts du Camp, 83330 Le Castellet, owner and operator of the Circuit.

Organiser: means any natural or legal person in charge of the organisation of any event taking place at the Circuit, whether it is an Event, a Public Event or a Private Event.

Rules and Regulations: means the present rules and regulations of the Circuit. The Operator reserves the right to modify these Rules and Regulations in whole or in part, at any time, in particular for safety reasons, improvement of the service or to take into account of the evolution of legislative, regulatory or jurisprudential measures. The amended Rules and Regulations are applicable as soon as they are displayed at the main entrances of the Circuit and/or published on the Circuit's website. If one or more provisions of the Rules and Regulations are deprived of effect under a law, regulation or final decision of a court or public authority, the other provision keep their force and scope.

Access Pass: means physical or non-physical medium, associated with an entrance fee, giving access to the Circuit. This one differs for each event occurring at the Circuit. The Access Pass may include a ticket, an accreditation or an invitation.

ARTICLE 2 - GENERAL PROVISIONS

Anyone entering the Circuit automatically and unconditionally agrees to comply with the present Rules and Regulations, along with the laws and regulations currently in force specific to the spaces hosting a sports event. Any breach of any of the provisions of these Rules and Regulations will be punished by the immediate exclusion of the offender without any compensation or refund. The offender may also be prosecuted.

These Rules and Regulations are displayed at the main entrances of the Circuit.

The Operator reserves the right to entrust the offender to the security forces, in the event of an infringement of one of the mentioned rules of the present Rules and Regulations.

It is forbidden to organise any event, of any nature whatsoever, without the prior authorisation of the Operator.

ARTICLE 3 - ACCESS TO THE ENCLOSURE OF THE CIRCUIT PAUL RICARD

3.1 Entrance fee to the Circuit

The Circuit is a private property, its access is regulated.

3.1.1 Access during Private Events and Events

When an Event or a Private Event is organised at the Circuit, any person wishing to enter shall present a valid Access Pass corresponding to the said Event or Private Event.

For spectators who come to attend an Event without being in possession of an accreditation nor an invitation, the ticket price is fixed for each Event. The price is indicated on the Circuit's website (www.circuitpaulricard.com). Access Passes are not refunded by the Operator. Any spectator shall respect, when applicable, the seat numbering and, more generally, comply with the instructions given by the staff in charge of the reception and placement. Unless otherwise indicated on the Access Pass, any exit from the enclosure of the Circuit is final. Some areas of the Circuit are only accessible to people with specific authorisation.

3.1.2 Access during Public Events and at the Xtrem Park

When a Public Event is organised on the Circuit, it is allowed to enter into the enclosure of the Circuit at the opening hours provided by the Organiser.

The access to the Xtrem Park and the Karting Circuit Paul Ricard is free during the opening hours of these spaces.

3.2 Security – Entry Controls

Any person entering the Circuit may undergo possible palpations requested by staffs of control and security services and/or an identity check, and may be asked to present the items he is carrying with him in his clothes, hand luggage and vehicle, in compliance with the laws and regulations in force. Any person refusing to submit to said security measures will be refused entry into the enclosure of the Circuit.

3.3 Minors

Minors must be accompanied by an adult and placed under his responsibility, failing which they will not be able to enter into the enclosure of the Circuit.

3.4 Animals

Animals are not accepted in the Circuit.

3.5 Traffic and Parking

Inside the enclosure of the Circuit, as well as the parking spaces as the access roads, the provisions of the Traffic Laws apply. It is mandatory to respect the traffic speed limitations indicated by the signs along the access roads, namely 40 km/h on the main access roads and 10 km/h in the paddock and in the parking spaces. This enables the vehicle to be stopped in any circumstance. The drivers are in compliance with the instructions sent by the security staff of the Operator or the Organiser.

Inside the enclosure of the Circuit, it is forbidden to ride a motorised land vehicle and in particular a scooter or «Pocket Bike», without having been authorised by the Operator or the Organiser. It is mandatory to wear a helmet to ride authorised two-wheeled engines.

The parking of vehicles is regulated and allowed on the spaces reserved for this purpose. All inconvenient vehicles will be removed without the possibility of complaint from the offenders.

It is necessary to get the prior authorisation of the General Management of the Circuit to park outside the opening hours of the Circuit.

It is recommended not to leave any items in full view or anything of value in the vehicles. The Operator declines any responsibility in case of degradation, theft or damage caused.

It is forbidden to leave marks on the ground (writings, landmarks, etc.).

ARTICLE 4 - PROHIBITIONS

4.1 Prohibited behaviours

Inside the enclosure of the Circuit, any person shall adopt an adequate behaviour that must not harm themselves or others, and must not endanger the safety of the staff and third parties.

It is strictly forbidden to climb or cross the barriers, railings and fences of the Circuit. More generally, it is forbidden to infringe any restriction displayed in the enclosure of the Circuit.

It is forbidden to throw projectiles, especially on the track or through the grandstands, in accordance with article L332-9 of the French sport code.

It is forbidden to do in any kind of business or advertising in the Circuit without the permission of the Operator or the Organiser.

It is forbidden for any intoxicated person to enter the Circuit. It is also prohibited to consume or do business with drugs or any other illicit products within the enclosure of the Circuit.

It is forbidden to deteriorate or damage the Circuit, for example by putting graffiti or posters on walls and trees, to deteriorate damaging plantations, tearing and removing plants, mutilating trees and climbing trees. It is also forbidden to throw trash, paper and chewing gum on the floor.

Smoking is prohibited in enclosed areas of the Circuit and in any place where such prohibition is indicated by a pictogram. Fire alarms can only be triggered in case of emergency. Any abuse will be punished.

It is forbidden to engage in any violent, racist or abusive behaviour.

Generally speaking, the public is asked to avoid causing, by its attitude, its behaviour and its words, any confusion whatsoever to the good conduct of any event and to jeopardise the safety of the participants, the public, the Circuit staff and the goods in the enclosure of the Circuit.

ANY PERSON ENTERING THE ENCLOSURE OF THE CIRCUIT SHALL COMPLY WITH ANY INJUNCTIONS OR RECOMMENDATIONS DIRECTED TO THEM BY THE SECURITY SERVICE MANDATED BY THE OPERATOR AND / OR THE ORGANISER.

4.2 Prohibited objects

It is forbidden, without the permission of the Operator, to introduce into the enclosure of the Circuit:

- Any alcoholic drink, in accordance with Article L 3321-1 of the Public Health Code;
- Any weapon, within the meaning of article 132-75 of the Penal code;
- Any explosive, volatile or flammable substance as well as any pyrotechnic device;
- Any glass packaging.

Fire is prohibited, but electric and gas barbecues are tolerated (open flame prohibited).

Balls and ball games are strictly forbidden inside the Circuit, except for exceptional events authorised by the Operator.
The Operator reserves the right to prohibit any object or device if it causes a threat to the safety of those present on the Circuit.

ARTICLE 5 – IMAGE RIGHTS – VIDEO SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM

Anyone entering the Circuit authorises the Operator to use the pictures where he could appear. Any photograph taken by the Operator in its enclosure may be used for communication and/or commercial purposes.

The General Management authorises taking and using photos and videos of the Circuit for a personal use. The General Management does not authorise the use of the Circuit image for communication or commercial purposes except in the context of a contractual authorisation. Taking pictures of the Circuit is subject to prior authorisation by the General Management.

The use of drones on the enclosure of the Circuit is subject to prior authorisation by the General Management.

A CCTV system is used at the Circuit. The pictures are recorded and kept for seven (7) days; they are likely to be used especially in case of legal proceedings.

In accordance with the provisions of article L253-5 of the Internal Security Code, any access to the pictures will be made on the site, with the presence of an employee of the Operator or a person authorised by him and may be subject to a written request (mail or email) within a period of seven (7) days sent to the Operator or his service provider at the following address:

ARTICLE 6 – TERMS APPLYING TO TENANTS OF FACILITIES LOCATED INSIDE THE ENCLOSURE OF THE CIRCUIT PAUL RICARD

Unless authorised by the Operator, any tenant of facilities located inside the enclosure of the Circuit undertakes not to contact, directly or indirectly, (i) the clients of the Operator and/or the clients of the Operator's clients, and (ii) any Organiser and/or clients of the Organiser of an Event, a Public Event and/or a Private Event, in order to set up marketing, promotional, communication, and hospitality services during said Events, Public Events and/or Private Events.

When an Event is organised on the Circuit, only tenants' employees will be allowed to enter the Circuit; in this case, the tenant must make a request to the Operator for accreditations for his employees (staff register, payslips of the last three months, etc.). Any other person invited by the tenant wishing to access the Circuit must have been authorised by the Operator and the Organiser of the Event.

Security Information Briefing

- *Maximum 2 people per vehicle, i.e. the driver and one passenger.*
- *You must wear the security equipment that is appropriate for the category of your driving session.*
- *It is mandatory to stay on the track and to respect the trajectory.*
- *Speed limits:*

In the garage/vehicle storage area = 10 km/h

In the pitlane = as indicated on the track

- ***Please be careful when you enter the track***, at the end of the pit lane.
- *Respect the road markings.*
- *Please also be careful when you exit the track.*

It is forbidden to stop your vehicle on the track. However, if it is absolutely necessary, it is highly recommended to stop on the left hand side of the track and to get as close as possible to the marshals.

To access the service road (VS) you will have to follow the orange markings.

Communication on the track:

The security rules are communicated by the following lights and flags:

- ***Yellow:*** *Incident on the track, speed reduction, no overtaking, no stopping.*
- ***Green:*** *End of the incident / End of the grip change.*
- ***Red and yellow stripes:*** *Grip change; speed reduction and no overtaking.*
- ***Red:*** *Incident on the track. Track is closed and access is given to the medical and technical assistance teams.*

5. Respect of the security rules and mandatory insurance

I attest and guarantee that my vehicle and the safety equipment, which I am committed to wear, comply with the technical security rules in force. I also attest and guarantee that my vehicle complies with the legal obligations required by article L 211-1 of the French Insurance Code.

6. Liability release

As the driver, I release EXCELIS and his insurance company from any and all responsibilities / liabilities in case of an accident, a robbery, or corporal and/or material damage that could happen to me or my belongings or may occur during the event except in case of inexcusable fault on the part of EXCELIS or its employees. I am fully aware of the risks I am taking while practicing a mechanical sport and I accept them; as a consequence, I agree to hold EXCELIS, the Organization and their insurance company entirely free from any liability.

7. Personal data

For the purposes of this Event, EXCELIS is required to collect personal data about the participants to the speed circuit driving service to which they are party. Those personal data are also necessary for legitimate security purposes. Hence, the participant hereby authorizes EXCELIS to carry out identity checks.

The data collected are recorded in a file by EXCELIS and this file is intended only for EXCELIS.

Those data will be kept for a maximum period of three (3) years in the absence of participation in another driving session during this period.

Any person concerned by the processing of those data has the right to query, access, amend and delete this data.
